DEER TAXIDERMISTRY INSTRUCTOR

15X State Champion James Graham

James Graham's taxidermy career may not have started where you think. His story goes like this: young man gets degree, young man gets job, young man has new baby and young wife, young man needs more money.

James had always been interested in taxidermy, so he visited the local shops, but no one was looking to hire. Randy Cooper, a taxidermist in St Charles Missouri, made him an offer, "work evenings for a little gas money and we will see how it works out". James grasped the opportunity and found his destiny.

Within a couple of months, he was hired full time at Randy's shop and spent a year and half learning, mounting, and experiencing life as a taxidermist. Fast forward two years, it is now 1997 and James moved back closer to home and opened Wild Creations Taxidermy in Frankford, Missouri.

James Graham has competed at taxidermy shows from the beginning of his career. His list of awards could be some of the most impressive ever given to any single person. 5 Best of Shows, 3 Wasco Awards, 4 Breakthrough Awards, 15 Times Best Whitetail in the State of Missouri, 8 State Championships, 3 Woody Awards, and in 2018 James was added to the Missouri Taxidermy Hall of Fame. His natural ability is off the charts and he has earned a competition career that dreams are made of. If you spend any time with him at all you can feel his intense passion and drive. He literally loves his trade, and his willingness to share his knowledge to help fellow taxidermists has made him a highly requested judge and seminarian.

James is still out there striving for his own personal competition goals, yet he is willing and excited to share his techniques and expertise. From basics and beyond for beginners to details and artistic composition for masters, you are sure to see whitetail deer a little differently when you spend time in the classroom with James Graham.
